



DEAR READERS,

Welcome aboard SpiceJet!

It's spring and we have good news. SpiceJet is back in the black!

The continued love and patronage you have showered on us have resulted in a strong showing by SpiceJet as our Net Profit jumped fivefold in the December quarter backed by an excellent performance in both our passenger and cargo businesses.

We exceeded our operational targets and continued with our unmatched performance clocking the highest load factor for every single month in 2022. There are renewed signs of recovery and some very positive developments and restructuring initiatives in the immediate offing that would significantly strengthen and deleverage our balance sheet.

Air travel has come roaring back, touching newer heights and giving a glimpse of the huge potential of the Indian aviation market and we look forward to a robust and exciting 2023.

SpiceJet continues to add new flights and strengthen its domestic network to make flying more affordable and accessible. We have added 12 new flights to connect Goa's Manohar International Airport with major cities in the country. The new airport will serve as an important entry point into North Goa for domestic as well as international tourists and travellers. We look forward to adding more flights to the new Mopa airport in the near future.

We have also extended our network to Shillong, the capital of Meghalaya. Shillong is an important regional

hub. The rolling hills and natural scenic beauty has earned the sobriquet – Scotland of the East. The State also has famous tourist attractions such as the living roots bridge and Cherrapunji, one of the wettest places in the world. We launched operations to Shillong on February 24. SpiceJet is the only Indian carrier operating non-stop flights between Delhi and Shillong.

The Indian aviation market is poised to surpass the growth of previous years as domestic air traffic has already reached 86% of pre-covid levels in 2022. Despite the lean period in air travel, we continue to register high footfalls. Our passenger load factor for January 2023 is 91%, the highest among scheduled domestic airlines. The sector too is scaling new highs and has surged to a new post-covid record. The average daily domestic air passenger numbers have increased to around 420,000 in February 2023 from 410,000 in December 2022. India is currently the third-largest aviation market in the world and air traffic is on the rise. With a host of G20 meetings coming up in the country and other underlying factors, there is scope for air traffic in the country to grow further.

The union budget's proposal to revive 50 aircraft landing sites comprising airports, heliports, water aerodromes and advanced landing grounds is a big boost to the aviation sector. The proposal will help improve connectivity with the underserved and unserved airports to increase the reach and footprint of aviation on domestic routes.

I join the nation in celebrating the U-19 women's team for their stellar performance in the first-ever ICC Under-19 Women's T20 World Cup. They have made us proud by winning the Cup with a comprehensive victory over England. Congratulations to the team on this historic win and may this be the first of many. I hope that their winning performance continues to delight us all.

I would also like to extend my best wishes to the Indian women boxers participating in The IBA Women's World Championships, which are set to take place in New Delhi from 15th to 31st March 2023.

While the festival is celebrated in many ways across the state with Lathmaar Holi (when Barsana's women beat up men from Nandgaon with sticks), Laddoo-maar Holi (sweet laddoos are thrown) and more, Phoolon ki Holi, is a sublime floral event at Vrindavan's Banke Bihari Temple.

The university town of Santiniketan in West Bengal celebrates spring with songs and poems of Nobel Laureate Rabindranath Tagore



WHAT TO SEE

During the festival, bright hues take the centre stage. with women dressed in yellow and mustardcoloured sarees, with garlands of orange palash flower in their hair. Tagore had penned many songs in ode to spring and these are sung as the processions go around. A cultural programme is also organised in the morning at the university. "Ore grihabashi, khol daar khol, laglo je dol... (O home dweller, open the door, the festival of Dol is here)" is a popular Rabindra sangeet (song) sung during the festival!

In the evening, cultural programmes are held across the campus, including the popular one presented by students of Sangeet Bhavan

town around 160 km from Kolkata in West Bengal, is associated with celebrated Nobel laureate Rabindranath Tagore. It is where Tagore setup the Visva-Bharati University that promotes a unique form of education. Among the many festivals the poet propagated was Basanta Utsav or Dol Utsav, which celebrates the season of spring. It is as much a celebration of the

colours of spring as it's an ode to nature. On the day of the festival, university students dressed in traditional attire dance and sing in processions.

They go around the campus, as residents join in throwing abeer (colour powder) and flower petals.







Take note: Check out the Chashme Shahi Garden for the natural spring flowing through it and the nearby Pari Mahal. Pay a visit to the Shankaracharya Temple and see the stunning snow-capped mountains from here. Pit stops at Nigeen Lake, Nishat Gardens and Shalimar Bagh are recommended.



Thekkady

A plantation town near the Periyar Tiger Reserve, Thekkady is known for its beautiful forests and wildlife, and spring is an apt season to explore. Spot elephants, lion tailed macagues, Malabar giant squirrels and endemic Nilgiri langurs. One of the rare forests that offers a boat safari, the Periyar Lake is where you can sight birds like the Malabar grey hornbill and Nilgiri wood pigeon. The Periyar National Park offers several ways to make the most of the wildlife experience as you can enjoy half and full day guided trekking tours as well as opt for camping at select locations. If you can, do enjoy the day-long rafting cum trekking programme. Within the reserve, you can visit the Mullaperiyar Dam. With around 2,000 species of flowering plants and 143 orchid variants, the park is a nature's paradise.





SHRUTI SRIVASTAVA


Senior Cabin Crew, Hyderabad

pilots but realised that at that time women could not enrol for a fighter pilot programme.




KARUNA JOSHIFirst Officer (Boeing)Flight Operations




SHWETA DANGExecutive- Legal & Secretarial






Sudhi Mudgal dreamt of being a part of the aviation industry ever since she first began thinking about her career as a child.


The grand city of Gwalior is steeped in history and culture, holding close to its throbbing heart tales of the many kings who have ruled over the region


n erstwhile capital and seat of royal power, Gwalior is synonymous with the grand fort that stretches majestically along a plateau overlooking the region. The opulent power centre made legendary traveller Ibn Batuta call Gwalior a "fine town of white stone" and the former Governor General of Bengal, Warren Hastings, proclaimed it as "key to Indostan". Power play aside, the beautiful city is also a cultural hub, a Mecca for music lovers, who come here to pay homage at the tomb of musician Tansen.

GWALIOR FORT

Dominating the city is the formidable Gwalior Fort, built on a hill with a nearly perpendicular precipice. It was considered to be impenetrable. The fort is said to have been constructed around 6th century and embellished by successive occupants to give it a final shape in the next few hundred years. It contains several remarkable monuments and exploring them could take nearly a whole day. Start





with the two palaces - Man Mandir Palace and Gujari Mahal. The façade of Man Mandir, built by king Man Singh of the Tomar dynasty, is striking. Coloured ceramic tiles with elephants, tigers and ducks embellish its walls. A still-intact row of yellow ducks is one of the most-photographed details of the walls. Its underground chambers are equally fascinating with a labyrinth of passages, staircases and rooms. After the fort was captured by the Mughals, Jehangir imprisoned Sikh spiritual leader Guru Hargobind Sahibji here and later, Aurangzeb executed his brother Murad.

The other spectacular palace, Gujari Mahal (Gurjari Mahal), speaks of king Man Singh's love for his beloved queen, Mrignayani. The Mahal now houses a museum with priceless artefacts, including stone sculptures, terracotta figures, stone inscriptions, copper plate inscriptions, coins, bronze sculptures, paintings, and arms

and ammunitions. Inside the fort are several other landmarks like the beautiful Sahastrabahu temple, popularly called the Saas-Bahu temple. Another is Teli ka Mandir, a stunning monument inside the fort. While the Data Bandi Chhod Gurudwara is a new construction, it commemorates the bravery of Guru Hargobind Sahibji, who had walked free with 52 fellow prisoners!

ROYAL SPLENDOUR

The stunning Jai Vilas Palace is where the descendents of the Scindia family, the erstwhile royal dynasty, currently reside. The Jivaji Rao Scindia Museum here has around 25 rooms displaying glimpses of the royal lifestyle - giltaccented ceilings, thick curtains and tapestries, exquisite Persian rugs, and antique European furniture. One of the most photographed artefacts are the two massive chandeliers in the grand Darbar Hall, each weighing several tonnes!

MUSICAL HERITAGE

Gwalior is a city of rich heritage and culture. Home to the greatest musicians of all times. it's in Gwalior that music maestro Tansen was laid to rest near his teacher Mohammad Ghaus' tomb. Tansen was a jewel of the Gwalior gharana (school of music), said to be the oldest style of Indian classical music, and had contributed immensely to Indian musical traditions. Every winter, the city hosts the Tansen Samaroh - a popular music festival organised by the Madhya Pradesh government. Another legend, Baiju Bawra, also belonged to the same gharana.

ART AND CRAFT

Gwalior has always been a hub of stone carving, exquisite examples of which are visible inside the fort. Even today, the city is known for the art. At Gende Waali Sadak artisans chip away at stones to create beautiful pieces that are sold within

WHAT'S NEARBY

Padavali fort

Around 30 km away is the renowned Padavali fort, with a Lord Shiva temple inside. Interestingly, every stone used here has something to convey about the ancient era through its inscription and detailing!

Chausath Yogini temple

The well-known Chausath Yogini temple in Mitaoli village is just 35 km away. Parliament House in New Delhi is believed to have been inspired from the circular design and architectural intricacies of the temple.

The National Chambal Gharial Wildlife Sanctuary

A sanctuary hidden from the tourist eye, it protects the critically endangered gharial, the red-crowned roof turtle and the endangered Ganges river dolphin. It's about 100 km away.

Bateshwar group of temples

An hour's drive from Gwalior, in the neighbouring Morena district, lie gems from ancient times, the Bateshwar group of temples. The cluster of about 200 temples is spread over around 25 acre. The temples are dedicated to Lord Shiva, Lord Vishnu, and Goddess Shakti.


LITTLE MORE

f you thought "less is more" is the holy grail of the makeup industry, think again. The elaborate, ninestep skincare routine is not making the cut for skincare as well. This year, minimalism is the buzzword everywhere you look. Simpler routines with just a few vital products is what the trend skinimalism (skincare plus minimalism) is all about.

Across the world, skincare is witnessing a huge shift towards decluttering beauty routines, stripping back on unnecessary use of products and choosing to apply the bare minimum for optimal effect and healthier skin.

"Because there are so many different products and brands in the market, one tends to start hoarding. Over time I've learned to reduce the number of products I use and listen to my skin. If I feel my skin needs something in particular, I'll use that. I keep it minimal, especially during summer. Our skin needs to breathe. The less you apply, the better," says fashion stylist, brand consultant and skincare enthusiast Edward Lalrempuia.

The last couple of years have seen a bombardment of beauty advice, be it through print or social media. And most of this rhetoric is about using ingredients like Vitamin C, Retinol, Salicylic acid, Ceramides etc.

While dermatologists agree that these can have beneficial effects on our skin, they warn that these can also cause damage. Professional beauticians say the focus has to shift to

protecting the "skin barrier". Dermatologist Dr Reddy explains, "Harsh exfoliators, intense acids, and drying sulfates can eat away our skin's outermost layer, or what is referred to as the barrier. Technically, the skin barrier, or the stratum corneum, is the topmost layer of the epidermis and protects the underling cells, keeping the skin healthy.

Experts say a complicated skincare regime with multiple active products can compromise the skin barrier. Also having a nutritious diet is equally important

While pollution, age and over exposure to sun damage this layer, so does excessive use of active ingredients and uneven mix of multiple products."

Experts are advising barrier-friendly trends like probiotic skin care that maintains the surface-level microbiome and skin-cycling routines, which promote the alternate use of active treatments and restorative ones. "Going slow or quitting the use of too many products can help heal your skin barrier. When we go back to the basics, it allows our skin time to regenerate, and over a period of time this will make our skin more resilient," says the doctor.

Celebrity makeup artist
Namrata Soni, who is known for
her signature luminous skinlike look sported by stars like
Sonam Kapoor and Alia Bhatt,
elaborates, "Skin minimalism is
something that I've been a big fan
of for the last few years. Before
that, I was following a skincare
routine with seven to eight steps.
Now I feel, all that routine did was
clog my pores. I have decluttered
my skincare routine and advice
the same to my clients as well for
natural-looking, plump skin."

Experts also advice that we should first understand the needs of our skin. Says Ruchi Rupramka, a professional makeup artist, "The first step to identifying the right skincare is to identify your skin type. Each person has a unique requirement. So consult an expert and know your skin better before you start experimenting."

Adds beauty blogger
Debasree Banerjee, "One
thing that has really helped
me in narrowing down my
skincare routine is referring to a
dermatologist and understanding
what works for my skin. It's
important to understand the
ingredients that work for
your skin. Also, one has to be
consistent and patient with a
product for the desired effect."

Soni, who is also the founder of the beauty brand Simply Nam, sums it up, "Your everyday skin routine doesn't have to be expensive or complicated. It needs to be practical, affordable, convenient, clean and hygienic. Your routine should comprise effective tools and ingredients that are professionally tested with proven results."







From futuristic products to innovative services, here's the latest from the world of technology



Had a chat with ChatGPT?

Till about a couple of years ago, Al or Artificial Intelligence, was an interesting concept that seemed stuck in researches and studies. But, in end-2022, with the launch of ChatGPT, the popular conversational AI model capable of mimicking human responses, took the world by storm, bringing Al-enabled smart services to our mobile phones! The chatbot, powered by OpenAI's GPT-3 language model, impressed millions with its ability to quickly generate articulate responses to several types of questions. What awes ChatGPT users the most is the uncannily human-like responses that it offers! And now, OpenAl has dropped a teaser about the release of GPT-4 and has also said that it has been updated with improved accuracy.



WORLD'S 1st AI BOOK BY AN INDIAN COMPANY

A Mumbai-based company is said to have launched the world's first Al-written book! A set of Al algorithms coded by Mumbai-based Fluid Al has penned the book, *Bridging the Al Gap*, which the company says is the first book to be written by Al algorithms. While Al-enabled programmes can mostly write small paragraphs, the company says this is the first time a 102-page book has been written by Al codes. Fluid Al's co-founder, and CEO Abhinav Aggarwal said it took the Als just three days to complete the book!

AN INDIAN MOBILE OS

Android and iOS operating systems have been dominating the mobile OS segment. But now several new indigenous operating systems have been challenging the leaders. One such indigenous system is BharOS. Developed by an IIT Madras-incubated firm, the system software can be installed in off-the-shelf handsets and it's said it will let users install apps as per their interest.



FUNDS FOR INDIAN DEEP TECH START-UPS

Here's a piece of good news for deep tech startups. The Indian government has announced that these startups will receive funding under Digital India Innovation, and the government will also establish a "Digital India Innovation Fund" to aid such firms. A categorisation of an organisation, or more commonly a startup firm, with the explicit goal of delivering technology solutions based on significant scientific or engineering issues is known as deep technology (deep tech) or hard tech.



DEFENCE START-UP CHALLENGE

In a historic turn of events, Innovations for Defence Excellence (iDEX), Government of India flagship, signed its 50th SPRINT contract with Sagar Defence for Autonomous Weaponised Boat Swarms for the Indian Navy. This is one of the technologies out of the 75 challenges introduced by the Indian Navy under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav in 2022. The contract relates to an Indian Navy project of the Defence India Start-up Challenge (DISC 7) SPRINT initiative, and post development of the weaponised Autonomous Unmanned Boat, the India Navy is expected to place an order for 12 systems. The Defence India Start-up Challenge (DISC) is a competition in which problems from the armed forces are presented to innovators for resolution.

THE RRR EFFECT!

We still can't stop raving about Telugu film RRR that has made history by winning a Golden Globe for its song "Natu Natu" and several other international honours. But not many know that the SS Rajamouli-directed film has also used VFX! PhantomFX, one of India's most prominent visual effects company, was associated with the film. Interestingly, Indian VFX companies are much soughtafter in Hollywood. The PhantomFX team has worked on blockbusters like The Avengers and Transformers!

GOING GREEN, MAKING GREEN

The Magic in Mushroom

Mushrooms may replace plastic one fine day! A new research published in the journal *Science Advances* studied the fungus Fomes Fomentarius' incredible abilities and properties that could be used as a high-performance ultralight-weight material like impact-resistant coating for windshields, leather, headphones, memory foam, or aircraft exoskeletons.



From Carbon to Concrete

The cement industry generates nearly eight per cent of the global carbon dioxide emissions, accounting for nearly three times as much carbon dioxide pollution as aviation. But for the first time in the world, three companies have said that they have successfully trapped atmospheric CO2 to make concrete. This could provide a model for fighting climate change globally.





Say Yes to Wricks

An Udaipur-based start-up, Angirus, seems to have come up with a solution to manufacture sustainable and high-quality bricks; made in just a day from recycled waste! Called Wricks, the company says they want their product to replace claybased red bricks. This, they claim, can reduce the overall construction cost of a project by 20 per cent by deriving its raw material from waste.
