With the Indian Pavilion at the Dubai Expo, we sought to exhibit the substantial growth the country has witnessed through the years after Independence through the theme of 'India on the move'. The concept was translated into a kinetic façade with rotating elements that can arrange themselves to become a blank canvas for India to tell its story. It was one of the largest pavilions at the Expo 2020 and one of the only three Pavilions at the Expo to be retained for posterity after the event.

### What are the new signature styles or trends that have made a comeback in the field of Architectural designs today?

The design and construction field has experienced a fundamental shift in the last few years. We are now witnessing the rise of large-scale projects envisioned at par with international projects in terms of technology and innovation. In addition, sustainable development initiatives are being seen as the need of the hour in the field today. ## Which are the Architectural Marvels you admire most in Modern India and why?








## What message would you like to give to young architects, in terms of planning, inspiration and overall execution strategy?

# What is the source of inspiration for new and creative ideas?

Understanding the context of a project, vernacular techniques weaved with the contemporary interventions is a good design approach. Incubated from in-depth research, the objective is to acknowledge the strength and find ways to restore

the glory. Taking the example of our project Veer Balak Smarak, our inspiration were the lives of 185 children and 20 teachers at Anjar we lost in the 2001 Earthquake in Bhuj on January 26. Built in an area of 3.15 acres, the design provides the visitors an insight of the memories of the devastation and experience the pain of the families. Each installation is the reflects that incident and takes one on an emotional and meaningful journey.

### What are the architectural marvels you admire most in Modern India and why?

Indian architecture is incredibly diverse, which makes it impossible for an individual to talk about one. From ancient temples to modern skyscrapers, Indian architecture spans centuries and encompasses a wide range of styles and influences. It, often features intricate and detailed designs, showcasing the skill and craftsmanship of Indian artisans and builders. Many buildings in India also incorporate decorative elements such as sculptures, carvings, and paintings, adding to their beauty and cultural significance. Many buildings in India are not just functional structures, but also serve as important community gathering places, places of worship, or symbols of national pride and identity.

### What are the new signature styles or trends that have made a comeback in the field of architectural designs today?

The signature styles from different eras keep coming back in a more evolved manner with respect to the needs and requirements of the user in very systematic and smart ways. Learning from the vernacular techniques and incorporating them in a little more innovative ways, the point is how everything is the result of constant change and evolution. We have worked closely with the craftsmen of Kutch, practising their local crafts for hundreds of years, and in doing so we have understood the importance of the essence and practise of those crafts to a national and international audience.

### What message would you like to give to young architects, in terms of planning, inspiration and overall execution strategy?

Young architects need to understand the importance of space and planning and must learn to utilize it well. A good design is meant to solve the underlying problems faced by the user. Engagement is important in a space to make it more exciting and informative, having a lasting impression. A good experience is the combination of deep-rooted research, good planning, and proper execution strategy, making it a necessity to consider the right norms. Execution is as important as designing. To design something, you must know



how to build it. Experience created with the design needs to be a universal landmark of courage, knowledge, and innovation. Overall, be passionate, curious, and willing to learn. Architecture and design are challenging and rewarding professions, and success comes from hard work, dedication, and a willingness to embrace change.








# What is your source of inspiration for new and creative architectural ideas?

On a large scale, my source of inspiration is nature. It presents things that are beyond human imagination. The key is to be able to notice them. Travelling and observing the culture of different countries often serve as sources of ideas for new architectural projects. Of course, much can be gleaned from the

history of art and architecture - our civilization has accumulated a rich experience that cannot be ignored. And, of course, professional exhibitions, communication with colleagues, and observation of the fashion and automotive industries provide plenty of food for thought. Each of these areas has something that can inspire a new unique project.

For "Ivanka", the inspiration came from the theme of the Mediterranean, combined with the design of the French fashion



if we were to talk about some unusual projects, we are currently working on a project for a country house for one of our regular clients, who has given us carte blanche, trusted us completely, and relied on our taste. The house will be made in Balinese style, all glass and mirrors.

## What are the current signature styles or trends in the field of architectural design?


One trend that is gaining popularity in architecture is 3D printing. While it used to be a novelty, it is now becoming more mainstream. This technology is not only being used in architecture but also in interior design.

During the design week in Stockholm, I noticed that a lot of concepts were being printed on 3D printers. We also use 3D printing to create sculptures and art objects for our projects. Currently, I don't think that 3D printing is the most accessible technology, but it is heading in that direction.

### What are the most impressive modern architectural wonders of India and why do you admire them?

The first thing that comes to mind when talking about Indian architecture is, of course, temple construction. It is very interesting and close to me. I would like to specifically mention the modern and very unusual Lotus Temple in New Delhi - this structure is truly breathtaking.

When it comes to secular architecture, it is impossible not to mention the interesting



facade of the human rights organization SAHRDC building, also in New Delhi, which is famous for its unusual brickwork. And, of course, the futuristic cybertecture egg-shaped building in Mumbai - a real celebration of technology and bold forms.


## What advice would you give to young, aspiring architects in terms of planning their work, finding inspiration, and overall project execution strategy?

Le Corbusier once said, "You employ stone, wood and concrete, and with these materials you build houses and palaces. That is construction. Ingenuity is at work. But suddenly you touch my heart, you do me good, I am happy and I say: 'This is beautiful.' That is Architecture... By the use of raw materials and starting from conditions more or less utilitarian, you have established certain relationships which have aroused my emotions. This is Architecture."




ingenuity and creativity of Indian architecture and a source of inspiration for future generations of architects.

There was even a pristine river flowing at the base of the hill! The school had to be planned on terraces cut along the slope because of the terrain, which would prove to be a challenge in making it universally accessible.



However, we made sure that there were adequate measures to minimally impact the pristine site such as rainwater harvesting tanks, STP collection systems and low-discharge fixtures in the toilets. Further, we ensured that local flora and fauna would be used in the landscaping. In order to reduce the overall carbon footprint of the construction, locally available materials were used.

# What are the new signature styles or trends that have made a comeback in the field of Architectural designs today?

Architecture is seeing a resurgence in this idea of doing less harm, of responding to local contexts and looking beyond "green" architecture. We have to make sustainability and zero discharge projects major goals within the industry. In fact, the built environment and construction sector accounts




for 38% of global carbon emissions. The industry needs to consider how existing built structures can be reused and reimagined to minimize this.

# Which are the Architectural Marvels you admire most in Modern India and why?

Marvellous architecture may have different connotations for different people. According to me, an architectural marvel is foremost democratic, in the sense that it does not aspire to leave an egoistic mark on the face of the Earth. Instead, it justifies its presence by the structure's relevance to our needs, its longevity and its ability to evolve with the demands of the future.

# Why do you think this project is Top Level Architecture, please share some details?

Mussoorie being no construction zone. The challenge was to design & erect within a shorter time with energy efficient material, therefore steel structure was thought of & biggest challenge was 160 ft. wide steel truss structure erection without any machinery. The sports complex is equipped with a large solar panel array to generate renewable energy and offset electricity costs. This includes both photovoltaic panels on the roof and solar thermal



panels to heat water for the facility. LED lightings are placed throughout, which is more energy- efficient and longer-lasting than traditional lighting. Motion sensors are installed to ensure that lights are ON only when needed.

# What are the new signature styles or trends that have made a comeback in the field of Architectural designs today?

Minimalism is a design style that emphasizes simplicity and functionality. with a focus on clean lines, neutral colors, and open spaces. In recent years, this style has seen a resurgence in popularity, particularly in residential architecture Adaptive reuse involves taking an existing building and repurposing it for a new use. 
# What is the source of inspiration for new and creative Architectural ideas?



# How deep is the urban-rural divide in the Air Conditioning market?

# What is your market share in the residential as well as commercial Airconditioning Sector?

Currently, Haier has a residential AC market share of roughly 8.3% and a commercial AC market share of approximately 1%.

# Where do you see your company in the growth chart five years from now?


India's use of air-conditioning is likely to expand this year with the maximum temperature







can also camouflage columns & beams in a room. As a designer I could think of wonderful ways of using them. Wrap up a toy cabinet or use them on the toilet door to visually conceal its look. Use trees & plants design outside covered verandahs to give an effect of sitting in a forest!!! Run your imagination wild!!

Wallpapers are easy to apply. Prepare the surface by using a sanding paper. Fill up any cracks, holes with putty to give a smooth surface. Apply a base primer coat and allow it to dry. Start by applying the appropriate adhesive with a paint

roller along its length and then folding the wallpaper in on itself. Move on to the wall from one top corner and smoothen out the wallpaper gently after application.

Wallpapers are available in standard rolls which cover 50-55sft. Some even cover 75sft. For e.g. if you have a wall of 10′ L and 8′ Ht, you surface is 80 sft. You will need 2 rolls to cover that space. One important thing to note in using large patterned wallpapers is to see how the pattern matches between 2 rolls and hence may need some extra quantity.

Wallpapers come in paper base as well as vinyl base. The paper based are the most environment friendly ones while the vinyl based are easy to wash and clean with mild detergent!! The choice is entirely based on the place of use, life expected from it and the level of maintainance possible.

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
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
